

# Call for Papers: Deadline - 31 March 2006

## First Summer School of the Marie Curie Research Training Network 'The Economics of Education and Education Policy in Europe'

Organized by the Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR), the European Expert Network on Economics of Education (EENEE),

and the Department of Economics, University of Padova

Padova, Italy, 16-18 June 2006

The school is targeted at doctorate and post-doctorate students in economics and related disciplines. Topics covered during the summer school will include school quality, teacher incentives, school choice and competition. The lecturers for this event will be Eric Hanushek (Stanford University), Victor Lavy (Hebrew University) and Margaret Raymond (Stanford University). In addition to the lectures there will be the opportunity for selected participants to present their papers. Participants who are interested should submit a paper, or abstract, with their application.

The participants will be selected by the Selection Committee on the basis of the information included in the application forms. The Scientific Committee is made up of Giorgio Brunello (Padova), Stephen Machin (UCL and CEPR), Tuomas Pekkarinen (University of Uppsala), Ludger Woessman (Ifo Institute for Economic Research and EENEE). Candidates should fill in the enclosed form and return it to CEPR by **18:00 GMT 31 March 2006**. Candidates will be notified by 30 April 2006.

Participants will be charged EUR 300 covering registration, meals, and background material. A number of grants covering travelling expenses, accommodation costs and fee waivers will be available.
